CRITERIA

1. The applicant should be life member of AAM at the time of application.
2. The award will be given to Indian students submitting their Ph.D. thesis in Agricultural Meteorology in any recognized institute in India in the subject of Agricultural Meteorology only.
3. The Ph.D. degree notification / provisional certificate/ degree award, during academic calendar year (from 1st July of previous year to 30th June of the current year) are taken into consideration for the current year's award.
4. The student competing for the award has to go through course curriculum as well as thesis submission during his/ her Ph.D. programme.
5. In case of tie among the applicants for the award, the highest OGPA in Ph.D. secured by the applicant shall be the criterion for the award.
